

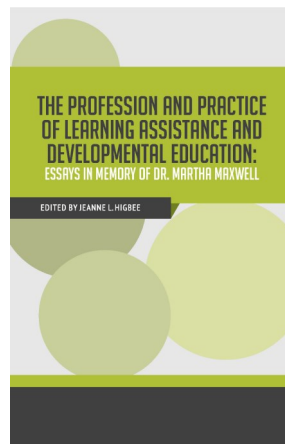
CLADEA FELLOWS

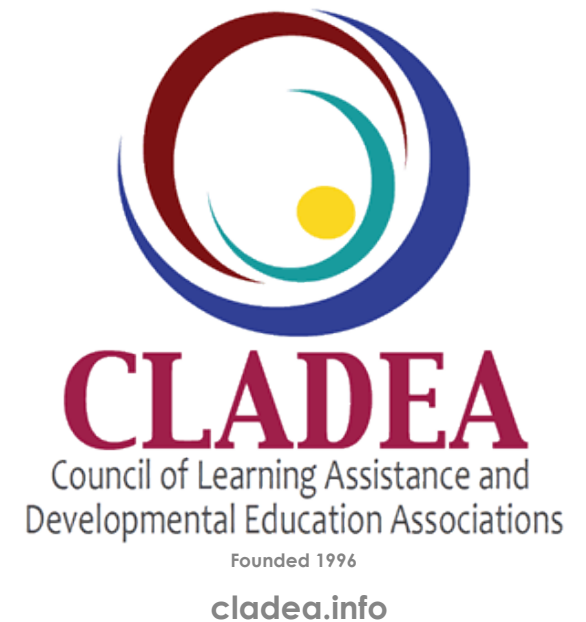

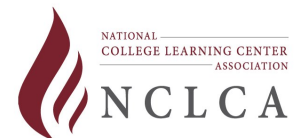

To provide a communication platform linking academic coaches, coaching supervisors, tutors, tutor coordinators, and administrators who are committed to the development of a successful learner.

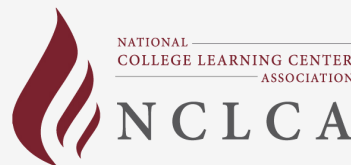

CERTIFICATION ENDORSEMENTS

The following certifications are endorsed by CLADEA.

ACTLA

- Online Tutoring Program Certification (\$300 for three years)
 - ◇ Certification adheres to ACTLA Online Tutoring Standards that focus on infrastructure, meaningful engagement, training, assessment, and evaluation.

ACTP

- Tutor Certification
 - ◇ Individual tutor certification offered on three levels. (\$10-\$30 per tutor)
- Tutor Trainer Certification
 - ◇ Individual tutor trainer certification offered on two levels. (\$40-\$50 per trainer)
- Coaching Certification
 - ◇ Professional Academic Coaching Certification for Individuals and Certification of Academic Coach Training Programs will be opening soon.

CRLA

- International Tutor Training Program Certification (ITTPC) (\$150-\$350)
 - ◇ Certification for tutor training programs on three different levels.
- International Peer Educator Training Program Certification (IPTPC) (\$150-\$350)
 - ◇ Certification for peer educator training programs on three different levels.

NCLCA

- Learning Center Leadership Certification (LCLC) (\$50-\$250)
 - ◇ Individual certification for learning center professionals offered on four levels based on experience.
- Learning Center Certification and Learning Centers of Excellence Certification (\$500)
 - ◇ Certification for learning centers based on best practices in the field.
